A basic loom display with the Dinè emergence story colors

There are many ways to construct a loom. You can use cardboard, purchase custom intricate looms or buy basic ones like this wooden one on display. You can see the light blue warp strings and the weaving yarn colors.

Dinè Dye Chart

Before modern commercial dyes, weavers would use resource around them to dye colors for sheep wool. The chart shows the plants use to make different yarn colors for a woven rug. Some colors were only available in certain regions and were named by their locations like Ganado red.
